TOO MANY CLEANING CREWS, MAIDS, HOMEHOWNERS WHILE CLEANING THE FLOOR, USE ONE BUCKET...WITH COLD WATER, CLEANING PRODUCTS THAT LEAVE FILMS, UNAPPROPRIATE TOOLS

RESULTING IN SPREADING DIRT AROUND RATHER THAN REVOMING IT.

TWO BUCKETS, ONE WITH NEUTRAL DETERGENT AND WARM/HOT WATER AND ONE WITH CLEAN WARM/HOT

WATER TO STRAIN DIRTY MOP WATER ARE NEEDED. A SYNTHETIC CLOTH, A LONG HANDED BRUSH

ARE THE VERY BASICS FOR A PROPER REGULAR MAINTENANCE OF ANY FLOOR.

NEEDLESS TO SAY...WHEN THE WATER OF A BUCKET IS DIRTY...OUGHT TO BE CHANGED.
